


C. What degree program are you pursuing now? 788 responses




D. What subject area are you currently pursuing?



1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class? 788 responses




2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes? 788 responses



4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as 788 responses














10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.



11. Your mentor does necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you. 788 responses


















