



He was conferred with Two Honorable Doctorates for the recognition of his individual responsibilities and for training more than 20,000 civil service aspirants also congratulated him for his writing to the Harvard Business School on Management Articles.

The Chief Guest in his speech effectively focused on the theme "Unexpected". He enlightened the young minds on how to elevate their personality in various aspects such as Social, Economic and Educational arena to meet unexpected scenarios which may be positive or negative. It was a proud moment for him when his words were converted into a speech of the President and Prime Minister which indeed was Unexpected.

In pursuance of the above, to motivate the students he cited three exemplary women personalities trained by him who achieved unexpected heights. They are:

- Ms. Beno Zephine 100 percent visually impaired student who became the First Indian IFS officer appointed during the tenure of Mrs. Sushma Swaraj, Minister of External Affairs and further the then Foreign Secretary to accentuate the efficiency of Beno Zephine stated that "If Beno Zephine is not qualified, we are all disqualified". In line with exemplifying Beno's efficiency, The Chief Guest Mr.Nandakumar I.R.S. quoted "insight is more vital than sight for the unexpected environment".
- Courageous woman Ms. Suchitha Salama having a weight of 46 kg, Superintendent of Police, Kolar District who had challenged the rowdy in the district herself alone with a revolver which even the male officers hesitated to do.
- Ms. Anna Poorani, a Tamil medium and First-generation student turned into an Army Officer from the Andipatti Village where the "Female foeticide" was in high rate and She led the 600 Army officers in front of the President by holding the sword in the parade ground. Currently Ms. Anna Poorani is placed in the Artillery Wing of the Army on the Indo-China border. By citing these three exemplified women the Chief Guest motivated the students to "expect to be unexpected". He explicates "Life is not a prescribed syllabus" where so many unexpected fetters may occur, so, the students especially the Women should take Education and Will Power as the weapons to develop their Personality.

In pursuance of the above the Chief Guest has come out with his life history that being a school dropout due to "Dyslexia", he worked as a child labour, however only his determination and will power turned him in to a Civil Servant, further, as per the guidance of the former President Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam has become a motivational speaker. Finally, during the Question & Department of Public Administration has raised a Question that, "What are the preferential methods for the Visually Challenged Students to become a Civil Servant? The Chief Guest had guided her well besides stating about the Benchmark disability vacancy provided in the UPSC and promised to join her in his free coaching class.
