MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

This non-financial Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter called as the 'MOU') is entered into on the 7th Day of February Two Thousand and Twenty-Two in Chennai.

BETWEEN

Anna Adarsh College For Women, Anna Nagar, Chennai, Tamil Nadu, India., herein after called as the FIRST PARTY represented by Dr.R.SHANTHI, Principal, Anna Adarsh College for Women.

And

Poshey Tech India Pvt. Ltd., Perambur, Chennai, Tamil Nadu, India., herein after called as the SECOND PARTY represented by its Founder and CEO, M J Logesh Babu.

FOR

CYBER SKILL DEVELOPMENT, HANDS ON TRAINING, WORKSHOPS, COURSES FROM US AND WITH OUR ALLIED ORGANISATIONS, AWARENESS PROGRAMS ON POSH, CREATING COMPLIANCE WITH INTERNAL AND EXTERNAL COMMITTEES AND OTHER RELATED SERVICES.

WHEREAS the FIRST PARTY was established in the year 1985, with student strength of 300 and 17 faculty. But today the FIRST PARTY stands with a strength of around 5000 Girl students and 215 strong teaching force offering more than 29 programs in two shifts (Shift I&II). The FIRST PARTY holds a strong Goodwill and reputation in the Education sector.

WHEREAS the SECOND PARTY is a new startup in the field of Cyber Safety, with the special focus on prevention of sexual harassment (POSH). The Second party had engaged themselves in various seminars, webinars, workshops, hands-on training, awareness programs, and certification courses for educational institutions, corporate, private, and public sector companies, NGO's, Govt. Organization etc.

WHEREAS the FIRST PARTY was searching for a party to increase awareness among students in the area of cyber safety and security. FIRST PARTY approached the SECOND PARTY in providing similar services. On acceptance of the FIRST PARTY's proposal, both the FIRST PARTY and SECOND PARTY came to an understanding and are willing to enter into this MOU with all consideration discussed. Now the MOU WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS

In particular, this MOU is intended to

1. Enhance Cyber safety mindsets among the students through certificate courses with and under the FIRST PARTY
2. Organize various workshops AND seminars on cyber awareness
3. Conduct practical sessions of training on Cyber Safety
4. Generate self-regulated activities in cyberspace
5. Assist the students in going further in the field of the cyber world
6. Creating awareness on Sexual harassment in the cyber world

NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

**Clause 1
CO-OPERATION**

1.1 Both parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and cooperation that will promote and advance their respective operations. The parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and share information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another. It is hereby agreed that no student information can be used without the knowledge and consent of the First Party.

- 1.2 The co-operation between First Party and Second Party will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the Second Party providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable teaching/ training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the First Party.

Clause 2

SCOPE OF THE MOU

- 2.1 Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be a major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.
- 2.2 The Second Party will give valuable inputs to the First Party in teaching/ training cyber safety so that the students get fit in handling the cyber world.
- 2.3 The interaction between the resource persons of the second party will give an insight into the latest developments/requirements in cyber safety. The training and lecture provided to students through this association will build confidence and prepare the students for a safe journey in a cyber career. The Second Party will provide its Labs/Workshops for the hands-on training of the learners enrolled with the First Party.
- 2.4 The Second Party will train the students of the First Party on the emerging technologies to bridge the gap in skill and make them ready for the next level of safety.
- 2.5 The Second Party will extend the necessary support to deliver guest lectures to the students of the First Party on the technology trends.
- 2.6 The Second Party will actively engage to help the students of the First Party into internships/jobs.

Clause 3

VALIDITY

- 3.1 The validity of the agreement is three years from the date of this MOU.
- 3.2 Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations.
- 3.3 Any dispute with regards to this MOU will be settled through Arbitration as per the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996.

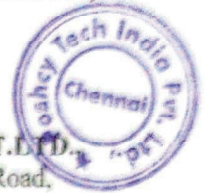

WHEREAS,

In December, 1985, Anna Adarsh College for Women came into existence under the aegis of the University of Madras. The college is managed by the Punjab Association, an institution steeped in philanthropy and social services. The college has been accredited with the prestigious 'A+' grade by NAAC placing it in the league of outstanding colleges in Chennai. What began as a small venture with just 17 staff members and 300 students has now grown into a mammoth institution. With 215 faculty members and a 5000 a strong student force, the college now offers 28 programs across undergraduate, postgraduate and research streams. The college ensures the holistic development of students through an ideal mix of rigorous academic schedule, multitude of extracurricular and cocurricular activities, competitive sports environment and a creative cultural scenario.

The Department of English offers graduate and post graduate courses in language and literature. An array of programmes facilitates effective learning and lateral thinking. Students and faculty members are trained to take up the internationally recognized Cambridge ESOL exams to ensure the relevance of their knowledge in a globalized world. The Literary Discussion and Debating Forum fosters an environment for students to argue, analyze, critique and comment on a host of classical and contemporary topics. The Film Society of the Department cultivates meaningful conversations about films paralleling the print with performance. The beginners bridge course is an attempt to democratize the reach of the language and making it relevant to students from varied socio-economic backgrounds and variable learning abilities. Guest lectures, poetry reading sessions, symposia, workshops are conducted throughout the year to complement classroom learning.

WHEREAS,

Prima Enterprise is a women-owned enterprise based in Chennai founded in 2021, whose mission is Celebrating Inclusion which includes both PEOPLE and PLANET. With this mission, one of PRIMAA's goals is to create awareness of water issues in Chennai with focus on community-based solutions approach.

PRIMAA intends to partner with various NGOs, Social Enterprises and women entrepreneurs to bring about change and create a lasting impact.

This Memorandum of Understanding is entered into by and between PRIMAA Enterprise, Anna Nagar, Chennai, (hereinafter referred to as "PRIMAA") and Anna Adarsh College for Women, Anna Nagar, Chennai.

PURPOSE:

Water problem caused by climate change and environmental degradation have dominated Chennai city life for the past few decades. Creating awareness and educating the citizens of the issues and solutions is an important part of the solution to Chennai's water problem. Government or NGOs alone cannot solve the problem. This needs collective community action!

The prospect of such work happening in a women's college, with and in the presence of a large numbers of women, has significance. Women representing the poor and the disadvantaged sections of the society suffer to a higher degree from the consequences of climate change. And raising awareness about this also warrants attention.

So, for the theme/form of performance and for the context, these two very important facets directly meet two important matters of culture that humanity must and needs to act on today - Gender and Environment.

Prima and the Department of English, Anna Adarsh College for Women agree to collaborate on:

- Organize Earth Day events on the Theme of Making Chennai a resilient city, specifically with Water problems / solutions in Chennai.
- The event highlight would include a short Contextual Play, with performances by student and/or faculty volunteers on Chennai's relationship with Water. The Contextual Play will be enacted with student participants across various public spaces, parks and communities to raise awareness and dialogue on Water.
- Other activities to engage students on the climate action theme would include performative elements like Poetry/Visual Arts/Debate, performed as inter-department or inter-collegiate competitions.
- Facilitate the formation of a 'Student Action Group' for community level engagements with activities like clean-ups or awareness building on the Water problems solutions in Chennai.
- Work with students to create documentation and follow-ups of activities

PRIMAA and Anna Adarsh College for Women are desirous to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding between them, setting out the working arrangements that each of the partners agree are necessary to engage with the Project.

Services to be rendered by PRIMAA include:

- Organize and host the Earth Day event for next 3 years, starting 2022
- Facilitate formation of a Student Action Group with the purpose of community engagement on climate action to build resilient Chennai.
- Organize community engagements outside the college, e.g., clean-ups.

Services to be rendered by Anna Adarsh College for Women include:

- The Department of English of the college will actively facilitate, enable and encourage the students of the institution to participate in the climate action play, activities and projects.
- The Department will assist in creating awareness about the project - through social media platforms.
- The English Dept will help design, conceptualize, organize and coordinate all inter-department and inter-collegiate activities.

RESOURCES

PRIMAA agrees to provide the following resources towards the implementation of the project:

- The resource persons to organize the Earth Day event until 2024
- The resource persons to organize community engagements

Anna Adarsh College for Women agrees to provide the following resources towards the implementation of the project:

- Time and space to conduct the events and planning & practice sessions
- Any other logistical/admin support required, which is available with the institution

In order to promote cooperation between PRIMAA and The Department of English, Anna Adarsh College for Women, Chennai (AACW), ('the parties'), the parties agree to the following:

1. The parties will encourage direct contact and cooperation between their administrative staff and other units
2. Within fields that are mutually acceptable, the parties intend to pursue the following general forms of cooperation
 - a. Volunteering for events
 - b. Conduct community engagements outside the college
 - c. Provision of material for community events & engagements
3. In respect to any particular form of cooperation, this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) may have, from time to time, written agreements annexed to it with regard to any specific project.
4. If this MoU remains dormant for three years from the date it is signed by the parties or by the later date of the signature if the signatures are not concurrent, it will be deemed to have lapsed. Where this MoU continues to be active, the agreement shall remain in place for three years after signature, and the parties may agree to review it with a view to extending its term.
5. For the purposes of this MoU, 'active' means some substantive activity under at least one of the forms of cooperation outlined in clause 1 above.
6. This MoU may be terminated at any time by either party by mutual written agreement or in any event by one month written notice from either party to the other for any reason or for no reason.
7. Each party will ensure that all public statements including statements to the media or articles relating to their joint activities are first cleared by the other party prior to release or publication.
8. No party will have the right to use the name or logo of another party without that party's prior written consent and other conditions attached to such consent.
9. The parties acknowledge that the quality and research standards properly established by each of them must be maintained at all times and that the relationship between the parties will not operate to constrain the other party from applying those standards.
10. Where a problem or dispute arises between the parties, they will seek to resolve that dispute between themselves and will use their best endeavors to settle the problem or dispute by direct negotiation.
11. This MoU will not involve any financial transaction between the parties and this MoU is valid for three years.

12. This MoU may be varied by a further written document signed by the parties that expresses an intention to vary this MoU.
13. This MoU does not legally or financially bind either of the two universities. Its aim is to promote relations that will mutually benefit each institution, this being the primary aim of the collaboration.



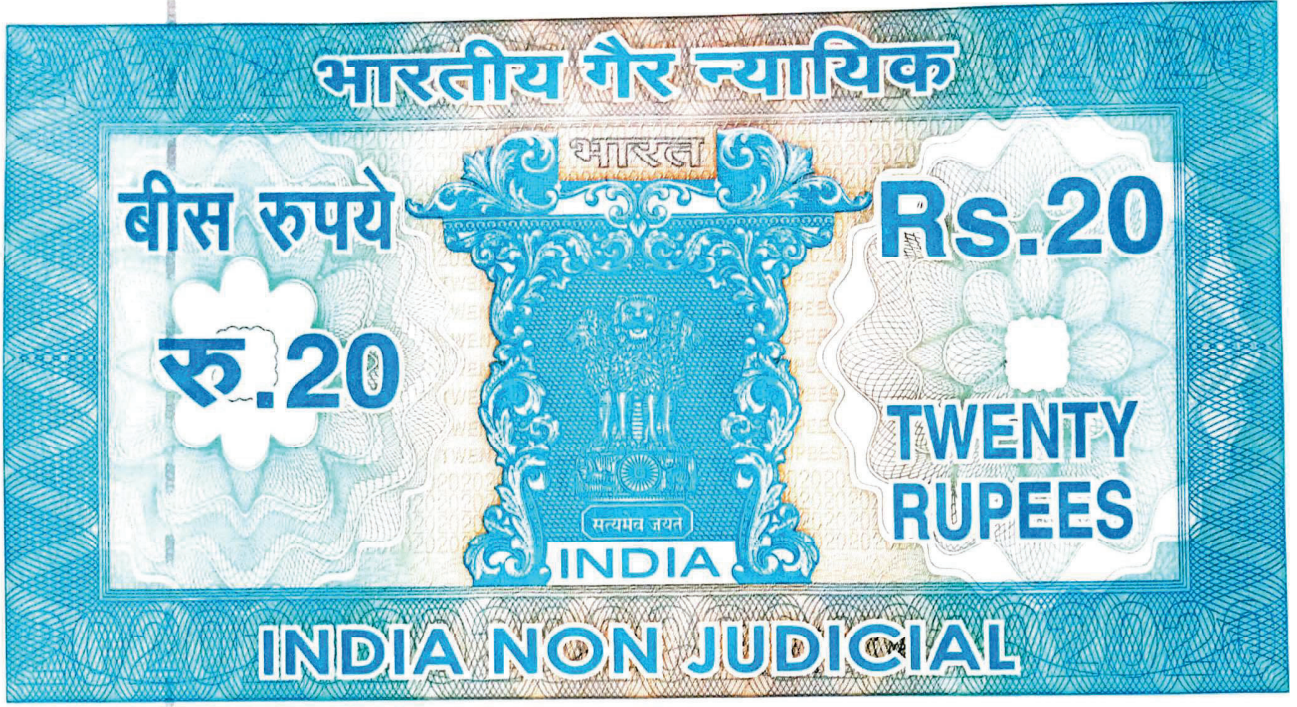

AND

Digital Security Association of India – DiSAI, the second party,(hereinafter referred to as **"DiSAI"**, which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors – in-office, administrators and assigns).

WHEREAS:

- A) The First Party is Post Graduate and Research Department of Commerce in this Higher Educational Institution named "Anna Adarsh College for Women" and the Second Party "DiSAI" is a registered Trust engaged in the field of creating, enhancing and sustaining awareness on subjects like cyber crimes, IT Laws, information security, data privacy etc more fully described in its registered Trust Deed and having its registered office in Bharat Nagar, Madipakkam Chennai 600091 (website: disai.com)
- B) First Party and Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.
- C) The Parties intend to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within the area of Skill Based Training, Education, Research and other academic activities.
- D) Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interests with no coercion or other kind of any external pressure or influence and in their free consent, legal power, will and volition

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MoU, THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

CLAUSE 1: CO-OPERATION

- 1.1 This MoU is signed between the PG and Research Dept of Commerce of the College as the first party and DiSAI as the second party and hence all further talks, action points, course of action etc will be between this department of the College only as the first party and DiSAI as the second party.

- 1.2 The College will be represented by Vice Principal and Head, Dr. Anita Raman (Mobile No.9840933043) and DiSAI will be represented by its Chairman Shri V.Rajendran (Mobile No.9444073849) under normal circumstances as single point of contact for any action arising out of this MoU. However, both the parties are at liberty to change the point of contact subject to the other party being kept informed beforehand and agreeing to such changes.
- 1.3 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Institution and its related wings, arising during the tenure of the MOU, further any student information collected for the purpose of a programme of DiSAI should not be used for any other purpose without the knowledge and consent of the college.
- 1.4 The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MoU and the Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, at any later date, in the form of any 'specific' agreements or document, to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MoU, when so felt necessary, under mutually agreeable terms and conditions.
- 1.5 Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge and hence will broadly work in this direction.

2.0 AREAS of MUTUAL INTEREST

- 2.1 **Curriculum Design:** Whenever so requested and required and subject to availability of resource persons and on mutually agreed terms, DiSAI will give valuable inputs to the College in teaching / training methodology, designing the syllabus or curriculum including conducting Faculty Development Programmes, so that the students fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully.
- 2.2 **Skill development:** Whenever so requested and required, DiSAI will strive to facilitate the Faculty and Students of the College to enhancing the contacts for any internship or other kinds of training related activities for student betterment and skill development.
- 2.3 **Certificate courses, seminars, workshops etc:** Wherever possible and feasible, DiSAI will conduct training programs, seminars, workshops including certificate courses on subjects related to its scope, for the benefit of the students of the College, at the College campus or elsewhere and all such events will be on mutually agreed terms and conditions like availability of resource persons of DiSAI, fees structure, honorarium, other costs, infrastructure facilities etc as may be applicable at that point of time.

2.4 DiSAI will be pleased to utilise or provide opportunity to the students and faculty of the College to address the participants in any event organised by DiSAI or where DiSAI is a supporting or other partner, in such a manner that the students and faculty of the College will be motivated and enhance their skills in the subject.

2.5 **Guest Lectures:** DiSAI strive to arrange for guest lectures at the College campus or at any other suitable place, for the benefit of the students either exclusively for them or jointly with any other academic or other institutions on topic within its scope on mutually agreed terms and motivate the students in such areas of skill development, public speaking and knowledge empowerment.

2.6 **Skill based training Programs:** DiSAI will strive to train the Faculty and students of College on the emerging trends and technologies especially in the digital space and to open a Student Chapter or a Campus Chapter in the College, in order to bridge the skill gap and make the students industry ready, to make them better employable especially in the area of digital security, cyber forensics, cyber crimes, IT Laws and other related areas.

2.7 **Conduct of Meetings and other events:** The College will try to provide its class-room or hall or auditorium or other space in the college campus to facilitate DiSAI to conduct its seminar, workshops, meetings or other events which may be organised jointly with the College.

2.8 Both Parties agree that this MoU is being signed with no financial commitment on the part of either of the parties viz the College, the First Party and DiSAI (second party) as a pre-condition to sign this MoU. If there is any financial consideration in the conduct of any future event in the form of any seminar, meeting or conclave etc it will be dealt separately and will be on mutually agreed terms at that point of time.

3.0 VALIDITY

This Agreement will be valid for a period of two years and during this period of two years; it can be terminated by either Party by giving one month notice to the authorised person (designated as the contact person by the parties). Any work that is in progress at that point of time will be completed on mutually agreed terms. Any act on the part of DiSAI, the Second Party, after termination of this Agreement by way of communication, correspondence etc., shall not be construed as an extension of this MOU, unless so clearly expressed.

4.0 RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES



Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

Any divergence or difference derived from the interpretation or application of the MOU shall be resolved by arbitration between the parties as per the Arbitration Act, 1996. The place of arbitration shall be at Chennai. This undertaking is to be construed in accordance with Indian Law with exclusive jurisdiction in the Courts of Chennai.

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


