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

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


Brief Report:


Brief Report:

The experts who took part are from Russia - Olga Aganson, PhD (History), leading research fellow at the Faculty of History, Lomonosov Moscow State University, Natalia

Piskunova, PhD (Political Science), Associate Professor in International Relations and Peacekeeping, Moscow State (Lomonosov) University, and from India -Ramu Manivanan Fellow United Nations University, Tokyo, Japan, Professor and Head Department of Politics and Public Administration, Chairperson, School of Politics and International Studies University of Madras and S.Marceline Head & Professor of Public Administration at Anna

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Adarsh College for Women. Webinar was opened by the speeches of Gennady Rogalev, the Director of RCSC and Consul Anton Chernov. All the speakers had a chance to talk about the results and significance of the last Second world war summit of the

Big Three and to review the postwar developments up to now on the basis of the Potsdam conference decisions. The discussion was hard and hot with many interesting assertions, approaches and interpretations of that event so important for the results of the Second world war and its further consequences for mankind. The experts emphasized the leading role of the

Soviet Union in defeating Nazism and its great contribution into the Victory made in the strong alliance with the United States of America and Great Britain. The experts agreed on great importance of the Potsdam conference for keeping peace and peaceful coexistence as well as cooperation during the postwar time. The talk attended by the listeners was sincere emotional

and open.





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

The event began with the blessings of God Almighty. It was followed by a welcome speech by Dr.P.Radhika, Head, Department of Corporate Secretaryship – Shift I.Dr. J. Srinivasan addressed the students on various aspects of COVID – 19 & New way of living. He has also thrown light on various aspects of stress, its types, symptoms, effects and sources of stress. He pointed out the difference between positive stress and negative stress where positive stress gives us energy and increases motivation and awareness

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
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but negative stress leads to headaches, digestive problems, skin complaints etc.He also added that too much stress will cause physical, mental and psychological problems.

She elucidated the radical changes that have taken place in various aspects like GDP, consumption decline, supply and labour disruptions and contraction in global trade. She also emphasized on providing new safety measures at workplace; job retraining and reskilling etc.,

Mrs. Varsha Kulkarni, Operations Intelligence Engineer, Micron, Singapore, spoke on the topic "Working Virtually in Manufacturing Industry. She elaborated on the availability of opportunities and challenges in the new world. She also explained how to be a good professional - know the basics of job, Humility, learn to respect the person not the role, quality over quantity and use of technology. She also briefed the students on the importance of being aware of women's responsibility in the workplace.



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A Special Address was delivered by Mr. Will Sheward, Vice President – Marketing & Sales, Isode, London, UK, on the topic "Charting the Path to the New Normal". 
Brief Report:
