REPORT OF THE WEBINAR ON

‘SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT – RE-IMAGINE, REUSE, RESTORE’, 05.06.2021

The Post Graduate and Research Department of Public Administration observed the World Environment Day on 05.06.2021 by organizing a webinar on the topic, ‘Solid Waste Management – Re-imagine, Reuse, Restore’ along with the Internal Quality Assurance Cell, to create awareness about the theme of the UN Decade, ‘Re-imagine, Recreate, Restore’ and to sensitize on environmental issues and sustainable living.

The programme began with a Welcome Address given by Dr.S.Marceline Pushpa, Head and Associate Professor, who also introduced the Chief Guest, Mrs.Srividhya, Consultant and Trainer, M.S.Chellamuthu Research Foundation, Madurai. Mrs.Srividhya is a certified ‘Peer Group Educator’ for Swachh Bharat Mission and District President, Confederation of Women Entrepreneurs. She has been awarded ‘Swachh Ambassador’ by the Madurai Corporation for her contribution to the environmental well-being.

In her Special Address, Dr.R.Shanthi, Principal, recalled the Vedic texts and ancient scriptures that prioritize worshipping the nature. Due to the innumerable damages caused to the environment by the humankind over a period of time, Dr.R.Shanthi stressed the need to realise the same and conserve the environment for the present and the future generations. Also, she prayed and wished for a speedy recovery of the ones who have been affected by Covid-19 and urged the audience to get vaccinated at the earliest.

Mrs.Srividhya, the Guest Speaker started her presentation with the theme of World Environment Day, 2021, ‘Ecosystem Restoration – Re-imagine, Recreate, Restore’. She cited the Pallikaranai wetland at Chennai. It was once a habitat of several species of flora and fauna but due to rapid urbanization and developments in the surrounding areas, the wetland

is now being transformed into a dump yard because of the absence of proper solid waste management. She highlighted the interconnection of solid waste management with the achievement of 17 United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals. In the current pandemic situation, solid waste management could be practised at the individual levels by the 'reduce, reuse and recycle' concept. She further stressed the need for kitchen waste management at home as it brings with it a lot of environmental and economic benefits. It is to be first initiated with source segregation as biodegradable, non-biodegradable and hazardous wastes. The kitchen waste could then be converted using options such as home composting, bio-enzyme and waste to energy/ bio-gas plants.

Mrs.Srividhya practically demonstrated a simple sustainable model that could be adopted for kitchen waste management. She explained in detail the various steps involved in home composting such as source segregation, getting ready with materials, implementation and maintenance. Followed by this, there was an interactive session where the Guest Speaker clarified the doubts raised by the participants, some of which were related to home-based bio-gas plant, spreading of black-fungus infection etc.

At the end of the programme, Dr.R.Asha, Assistant Professor, proposed the Vote of Thanks. Ms.G.Hemalatha, Assistant Professor anchored the programme. The webinar was attended by nearly 50 participants including students, faculty from the parent College and other Colleges and Universities.

On account of World Suicide Prevention Day that falls on September 10, 2021, the National Service Scheme Unit of the College organized a Webinar on the topic, "Hold on to Hope" on September 09, 2021 at 4.30 PM in Google Meet platform. The Webinar commenced with the College Prayer Song followed by the Principal's Welcome Address. Dr.R.Shanthi, Principal, recalled her childhood days while she was comparing the sensitive attitude of children and teens in today's world. She emphasized on how one needs to hold on to hope for the best to happen in the future. She requested the Chief Guest to sensitise the youth community to stay spirited and strong hearted amid tough circumstances and lead their lives.

The Chief Guest Dr.Nappinnai Seran, Psychologist and Founder, PsyHub Brain and Behaviour Clinic, was then invited to take over the session. Dr.Nappinnai Seran is specialised in marital counseling and has been practising for the past 17 years. She is also an Honorary special counsellor for the family court for the past 15 yrs. She holds the privilege of being a member of the Board of Insurance wherein autism was included in the CM scheme. She has served two terms as a member of the Tamil Nadu Social Welfare Board and had also been a special counsellor for the prisoners of Puzhal Prison. She was an Executive Committee member of Association of Rehabilitation Professionals and Parents representing Tamil Nadu. She has also received an award from the Anugraha foundation. Dr.Nappinnai Seran started her speech sharing a statistical data on how many individuals become victims of suicide. Those who end their lives were called completers and those who attempt a suicide were called attempters. Suicide was considered to be the fourth major cause leading to death. Individuals in the age group of 15-25 years were very much vulnerable to suicide as they lose their tolerance levels and end their lives. She further cited that children use suicide as a threat to get things done from their parents. She stressed the importance of identifying the vulnerable people and validating their reasons and not to trivialize it. Hence, it is important to be empathetic and observant to look out for clues. Two different types of suicides were pointed out by the Speaker i.e., planned and impulsive, the former one sending clues/ signals in myriad ways also not letting anybody save their lives and the latter one which would be instantaneously done. Causes of suicide were highlighted such as depression, substance abuse,

rejection and schizophrenia. The most common vulnerable groups who commit impulsive suicides were doctors and farmers as they were having access to materials that they use to end their lives. The other categories were LGBTQ community and those with a family history of suicide. Further, she cited research evidence that 20% of the attempters or completers had tried self-poisoning, hanging or setting oneself ablaze. Hence, it is important to introspect oneself and work on improving ourselves if we feel we were not accepted socially for certain reasons. Feelings, Actions, Changes, Threats and Situations (shortly called as 'FACTS') are the warning signs to be identified in people who are likely to attempt suicide. Listening to the vulnerable groups, validating their reasons and helping them to adopt coping mechanisms would definitely help them to be hopeful about their future. An interactive session was held where the NSS volunteers raised doubts on coping mechanisms in times of distress, conflict with our own values etc for which the Guest speaker suggested grief therapy and choosing to be kind to oneself. Ms. Nangeswari from II B.Com General proposed the vote of thanks. Ms. Kusam, II B.A. Business Economics anchored the webinar. There were nearly 100 participants in the webinar including the NSS volunteers, NSS Programme Officers of the College and faculty from the College
