The Banyan approaches mental health from a well being lens, recognising it as multifaceted with social, cultural and economic determinants that need to be addressed, beyond identification and treatment of symptoms. We view the promotion of outcomes in social and economic spheres as preventive and beneficial to mental health.

Over the last twenty three years we have reached out to over 5000 people living with mental health issues, doubly affected by poverty and homelessness, through our various programmes. In this process we have developed new approaches towards mental health, that range from clinical care in inpatient and outpatient settings to social care in the form of housing, education, disability allowance and social entitlement facilitation.

Our Transit Care Centre has seen 1750 homeless women with mental health issues pass through its doors, of whom over 1300 have returned to their families and communities all over India. Close to 60 women with long term clinical and social care needs live in a row of cottages located alongside The Banyan Academy of Leadership in Mental Health (BALM) as part of an inclusive ecosystem consisting of residents, students and the wider community. The objective of this programme is to spread awareness among the students about the significance of cleanliness and keeping the environment clean.

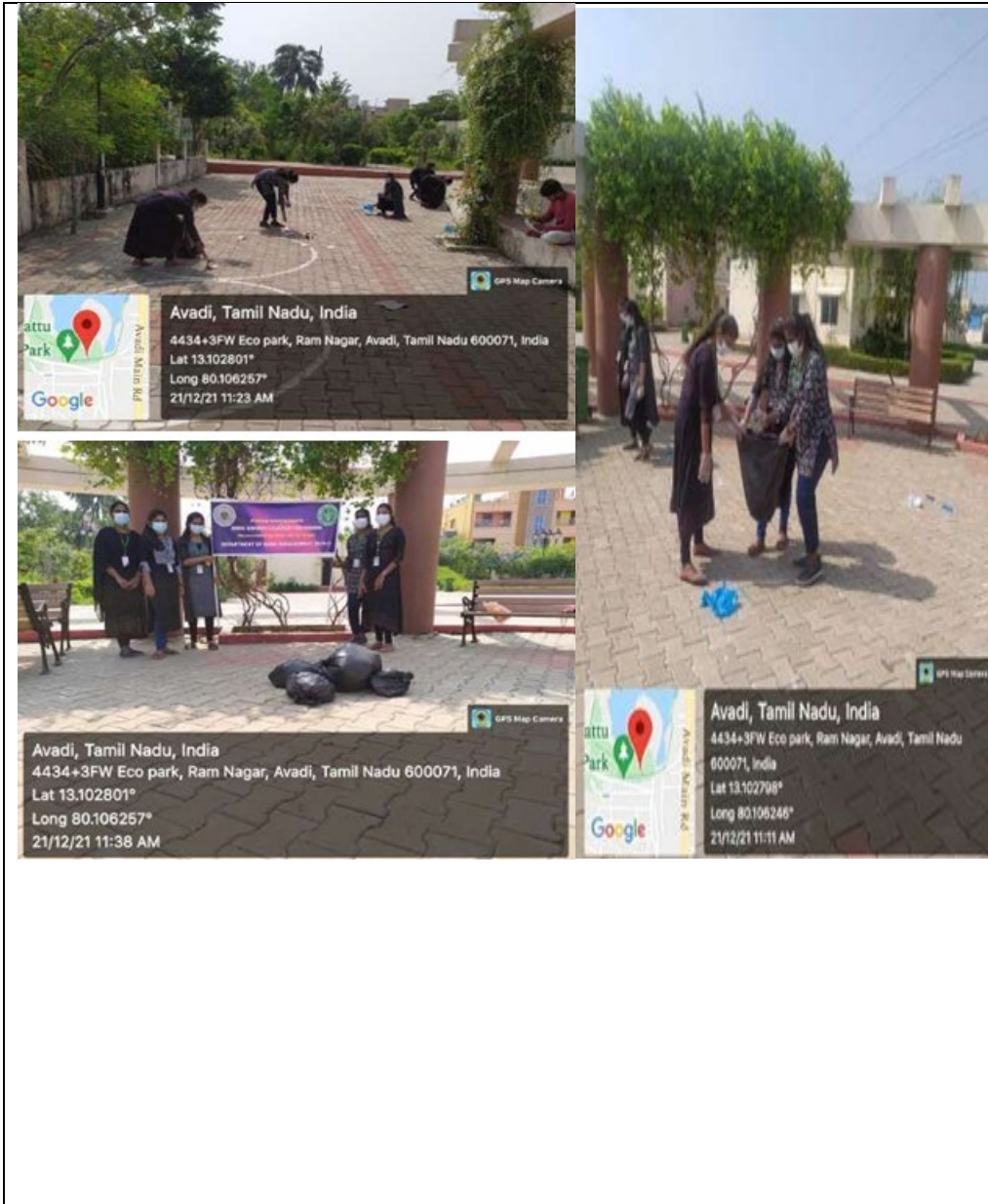

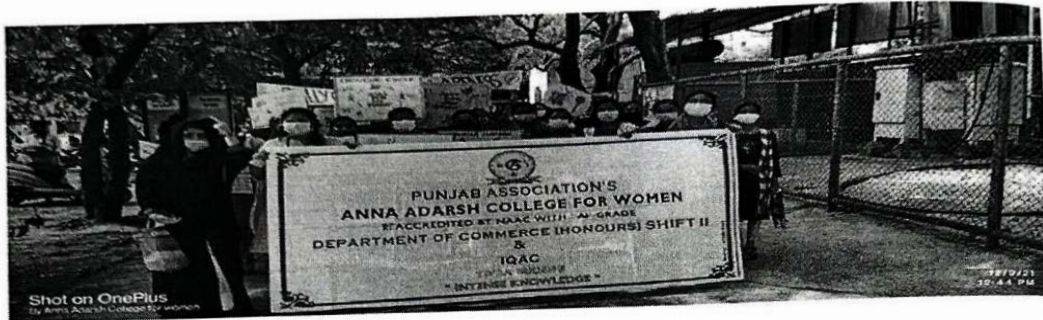

RALLY ON DENGUE AWARENESS

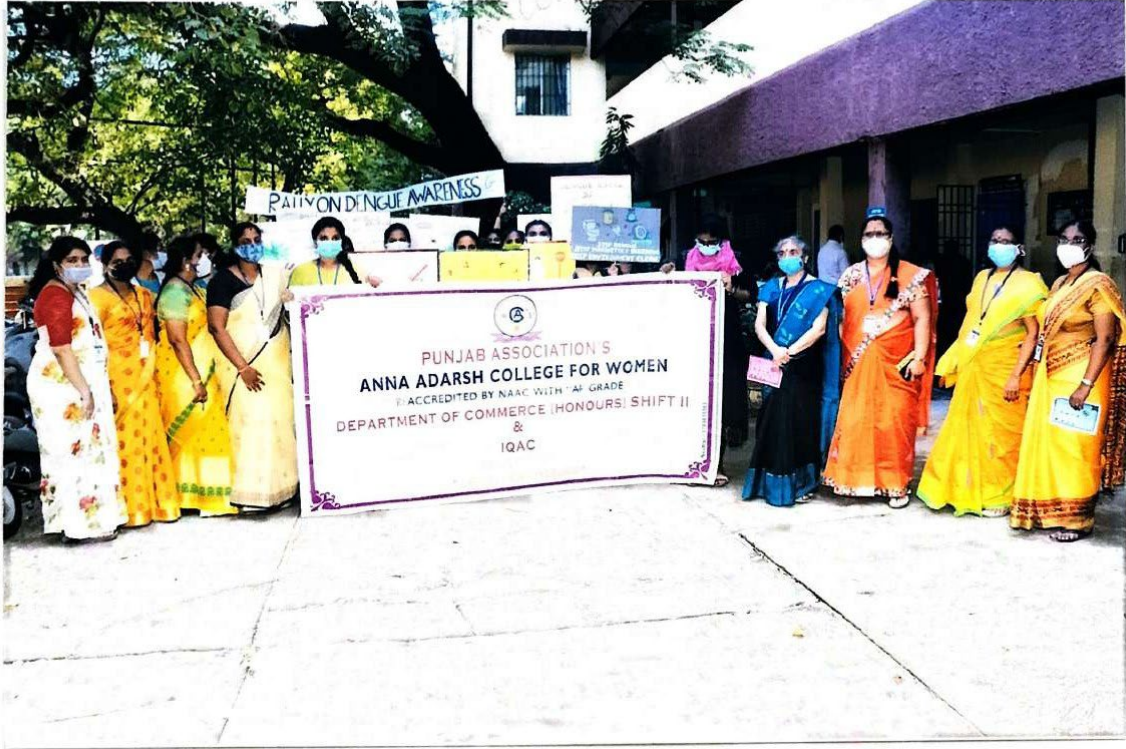
