QUALITY AUDITS

Quality Audits are conducted in the Institution for a systematic examination of the Institution's quality management system. Academic audits, Financial audits and Green audits are regularly conducted to evaluate the Institution through systematic internal and external reviews. These Audits help the Institution to identify the strengths and weaknesses and areas having scope of improvement.

Academic Audit

Academic Audit is carried out to ensure the quality of the academic performance of the institution. The Academic Audit is an annual academic exercise initiated by the IQAC to evaluate the performance of every department in terms of achievements of students, faculty and department as a whole. Internal and External Audit is done for all the departments and evaluates each department considering the various parameters such as Curriculum Design, Teaching learning methods, Assessments, Research, Consultancy and Extension Activities.

The Internal audit is a peer review process and the audit team consists of either senior teachers of the institution / Vice Principal and the IQAC coordinator. The external audit is done in the institution by external peers/ experts. The audit report is prepared citing commendation, affirmation and recommendation for each department. This exhaustive audit report of each department is consolidated and based on the audit, the IQAC gives constructive feedback to the departments suggesting measures for internal quality enhancement. It makes recommendations for the departments to do self-evaluation and to set higher goals to meet new challenges. The academic audit report shows the progressive nature of the college and its performance at the national and international higher education level.

Financial Audit

The Institution conducts internal and external financial audits on a regular basis. Internal audit is a continuous process which takes place after each and every financial transaction, whereby the college itself carries out the initial stage of the internal audit. In the initial stage, the Accountant scrutinizes and verifies the financial data. This is again scrutinized by the Administrative Officer and the Principal for clarity, authenticity, transparency and financial accuracy. An Internal auditor is also deputed by the management to carry out the continuous internal audit. The internal auditor checks receipts and payments with fee receipts, vouchers, and necessary supporting documents. He ensures that all transactions are duly authorized.

The external audit is conducted every year by a Professional agency - Chartered

Accountants Rajesh Kumar Shah & Co. The annual income and expenditure and Balance Sheet is submitted to them for the external audit.

Energy and Green Audit

The college in its commitment to sustainability conducts green audits to conserve energy, protect and promote the environment. The Green, Energy and Environment audits are carried out by an External body. Green Audit 2019- 2020 & 2020 - 2021 was done by Exnora International. In 2021- 2022, Energy, Green, Environment audits were conducted by Alcheme Green Energy

Company. Data collection was performed using different tools such as observation, taking a survey, communicating with responsible persons and calculating measurements. Site inspection was done and relevant documents were collected. The audits highlight the eco-friendly accomplishments of the Institution, its commitment to prevent pollution, the persistence to improve its environmental protection efforts and the readiness to work on the suggestions for further improvements.
