### **ICT Tools & Resources Available**

- Most of the classrooms and labs are ICT enabled with projectors installed and the campus is enabled with high speed wifi connection.
- Gmeet is used for lecture delivery with interactive methods for effective teaching such as PPT, Video clippings and Youtube links.
- Online assessments are done after the completion of each unit with the help of tools like mentimeter, Kahoot, Google forms and various Cloud portals etc.
- To earn and deposit credit through National schemes like SWAYAM, NPTEL, COURSERA, digital learning is encouraged among the students as an initiative of NEP2020. A digital learning portal is embedded in the college website [annaadarsh.edu.in](http://annaadarsh.edu.in) for facilitating students to earn credits.
- WhatsApp groups are used as platforms to communicate, make announcements, address queries and to share academic information.
- To teach problem solving subjects in an online mode, faculty use various tools like- interactive whiteboard in Google meet.
