

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


5. What subject area are you currently pursuing?






7. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?






9. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as 1,905 responses














15. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.








17. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.






19. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them.











SUMMARY:

The analysis of the Students Satisfaction Survey 2022-23 reveal that		
☐ 57.8% students agreed that 85-100% of the syllabus is covered in the class.		
☐ 57.8% students rated that teachers come "Thoroughly" prepared for the class while		
43.3% rated the preparation of teachers "Satisfactory." 1353 (71%) of the students agree		
that teachers illustrate concepts through examples and application.		
\square 45.2% say that 90% teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while		
teaching.		
☐ Majority of the students agree that teachers have good communication skills.		
☐ Majority of the students feel that the teachers' excellent approach towards teaching.		
☐ Majority of the students (62.6%) feel the teachers are "Always Fair" towards Internal		
Evaluation. 63.3% agreed that their performance in assignments are discussed.		
☐ 55.4% strongly agree that the college provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.
