



What is it

The blockchain is a decentralized ledger of all transactions across a peer-to-peer network. Using this technology, participants can confirm transactions without the need for a central certifying authority. Potential applications include fund transfers, settling trades, voting, and many other uses.

Someone requests a transaction



The requested transaction is broadcast to a P2P network consisting of

computers, known as nodes.



The new block is then added to the existing blockchain, in a way that in permanent and unalterable.

Validation

The network of nodes validates the transaction and the user's status using known algorithms. A verified transaction can involve cryptocurrency, contracts, records, or other information.

Once verified the transaction, It is combined with other transactions to create a new block of data for the ledger.

The transaction is complete.






